
6 Adjusting the Time

You do not need to adjust your meter when the clocks go forward or backward, this will happen automatically. The time can only be adjusted by up to 2 minutes forward or backward once every 30 days.

The time may be adjusted by the following procedure:

1. Place the meter into FOR HIRE mode.
2. Hold EXTRAS in and press TOTAL, the Extras display should now say "Sno". Now release both buttons.
3. Press TOTAL until the Extras display says "rtc".
4. Press SELECT once. The Extras display should now say "Adj".
5. To adjust the time forward 1-2 minutes press EXTRAS. To adjust the time backward by 1-2 minutes press the TOTAL key.
6. Press SELECT to accept the new time or REVERT to return to the original time setting.

1 Switching the Meter ON

Press the MODE button once.

After performing a display test, the meter beeps and enters FOR HIRE mode, which is indicated on the front panel.

In FOR HIRE mode the taxi's roof sign is on together with the FOR HIRE sign in the luggage door window. The roof light may be turned off by pressing the REVERT button once, when the words FOR HIRE on the front panel are also turned off.

2. Entering HIRED Mode (At the start of a Journey)

Press the MODE button once.

The meter beeps and enters HIRED mode, which is indicated on the front panel.

The metered fare is now calculated continuously. Any extras may be added to the fare by pressing the EXTRAS button until the required Extras amount is displayed.

3. Entering STOPPED Mode (At the End of a Journey)

Press the MODE button once.

The meter beeps and enters STOPPED mode. The mode is indicated on the front panel.

At this point the fare and extras may be added together by pressing the TOTAL button.

4. Switching the Meter Off

When in FOR HIRE mode, press the REVERT button twice.

The front panel of the meter is blank but will illuminate if the meter receives distance pulses (i.e. the vehicle is moved).

5. Totals

The meter maintains two sets of totals which may be read back by the user via the display. These two sets of totals include the same set of information

except that the first set may be reset via the front panel ("Temporary" Totals), and that the second set ("Permanent" Totals) may not. Note that the permanent totals can display amount up to £10,000 after which they roll over to zero.

To read the totals, in FOR HIRE mode press the TOTAL button once. The resettable totals are then displayed in sequence.

Pressing the TOTAL button then selects the total being viewed. The total being viewed is indicated by the digit shown on the left-hand side of the Extras display. The set of totals (0 = Temporary, 1 = Permanent) is indicated by the right hand digit. The totals types are:

Total Fare	F
Total Extras	E
Total Fare + Extras	=
Total Journeys	J
Total Paid Distance (Miles)	P
Total Distance (Miles)	d
Total Meter Reconnections	r
Total Rate Changes	c

The EXTRAS button causes the meter to alternate between the display of Temporary and Permanent Totals.

Note that monetary values are displayed without the last zero, so that, for example, £125.60 would be displayed as "125.6". This is to make more effective use of the display.

TO RESET THE TOTALS:

Holding down the REVERT and TOTAL buttons together causes the word "RESEt" to be displayed in the fare window. If the buttons are held down for two seconds, the display will change to "00000" and the Temporary totals will be cleared to zero.

Attempting to reset the Permanent totals will result in the message "ProtEct".

To exit from the totals display, press MODE or REVERT. Totals display will timeout automatically if no button is pressed for 10 seconds.
